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Why was MaBAL created?

- Known need prior to COVID
- Date of inception summer 2020
- Increased need/crisis with COVID
 - Increased concern of travel to providers
 - Increased concern of return to community (what is available for care)
 - ▶ Increased concern for real time intrapartum care 24/7 365
- Bridge for families / communities to other unmet needs

Who are the stakeholders?

- MaBAL (Maternity and Babies Advice Line)
- MaBAL-Maternity and Newborn is one of the <u>Real-Time Virtual</u> <u>Support</u> (RTVS) pathways for patient care and healthcare collaboration in rural and remote communities in BC.

Who is answering the line?

- ► Family doctors whom do OB in communities
- ► Soon! Midwives

When can one call?

- **▶** 24/7
- ▶ 365
